Hotel and Transportation Information

Hotel:

There is a reserved block of 30 rooms at the Wyndham Hotel which is near the Massachusetts Eye and Ear and the Massachusetts General Hospital. Since the number of rooms is limited, I recommend that you make your reservation soon.

Room rate: \$295/night plus taxes, fees, etc.

Transportation to Boston:

Airplane: If you're traveling by plane, Boston Logan Airport is the airport to arrive at.

Taxi, Uber, or Lyft: Fares from the airport to the hotel are around \$40, including tip. The ride should take around 20 minutes, longer if there is heavy traffic.

Public transportation: Those with time, not too much baggage to carry, and a desire to see the city with more granularity, can take the subway (the T). There is no need to buy a ticket! There is no charge for passengers traveling from the airport to anywhere in Boston. Just get on the Silver Line bus labelled "South Station" that stops at each terminal near the baggage claim exits. Once you've reached South Station, change to the Red Line train going downtown in the direction "Alewife". Get off on the third stop, named Charles/MGH. From the Charles/MGH stop, walk to the hotel which is about 3 blocks down Cambridge St. on the corner of Blossom St.

(Note: Although the T is free for journeys starting at the airport, you must pay a fare if you travel to the airport, or if you travel to South Station for trains to other cities. If you take the T at the end of the meeting, you can buy a ticket at the Charles/MGH T station. The fare is around \$3.)

Trains: Amtrak trains from New York City arrive at South Station. From South Station one can take a taxi, Uber, or Lyft, or one can take the subway (the T). If taking the T, one goes from South Station in the downtown direction (toward Alewife), and gets off at the station called Charles/MGH. The hotel is a walk of 3 blocks from that station.

The Registration Fee is expected to be somewhere between \$700 and \$900, less for accompanying persons. The fee will be established about a month before the meeting.
